

HOW IS THE ADJUSTED GROSS SCORE CALCULATED?

Stroke reduction for "Adjusted gross score "2020 Equitable stroke control"

For calculating an adjusted gross score...

Max hole score allowed is a "Net Double Bogey" = 2 over par after full handicap strokes are applied. (Example: if you have an 18 Handicap and you are playing a par 5 hole, you are allowed a score of 2 over 5 plus your handicap stroke, so 5+2+1 equals a score of 8 Max.

Number of scores Index is based on is 20.

Minimum number of scores needed
before an Index can be calculated.
